**Employing Active Learning Strategies to Engage Students in the Classroom**

**Room 7207**

**Presenter: Dr. Courtney Guenther, Dept. Chair, Natural & Physical Sciences, Professor of Anatomy & Physiology, Horry-Georgetown Technical College**

Faculty will be introduced to different active learning models and given specific examples on how to apply these models in the classroom. Examples such as the use of case studies, online video lectures, group work, and in-class activities will be included. Incorporating technology will also be addressed (“clicker” systems, Libguide, SMART boards, D2L) and live demonstrations used during the presentation. Discussion among faculty will be encouraged regarding pros and cons of various techniques. A brief written guide will also be provided to faculty to assist with implementation of new teaching strategies.

**Interactive Technology in the Classroom**
